A Virtual Race FAQs

1. What is a virtual race?

A virtual race is a physical activity that can be completed outdoors or indoor at any pace during a specific period of time.

2. How does a virtual race work?

Any participant can register for the race as an individual, join a team or form a team of your own. You can complete the race anywhere, at any pace, and at any time during the specified race period.

3. Who can participate in a virtual race?

Anyone can participate and everyone should participate and contribute to this worthy cause. We welcome and encourage all fitness and ability levels. Please invite your family, friends, colleagues and competition.

4. Do I have to run? Can I walk or perform another activity?

You can complete your race at any desired pace. Please feel free to use your treadmill, home space or go outside to walk or jog.

5. Do I have to complete the entire distance all at once?

No, you do not. You can break up your race over several days or hours at your own pace. You should select a pace that makes you comfortable.



- 6. How do I track and time my activity? Which running apps can I use?
 You can use any running app such as the Nike Run Club, Strava, Map my
 Run or a GPS watch or device.
- 7. How do I submit my results?

You may send a screenshot of your time, distance and trail if the trail is provided by your app or GPS tool. Please send your information to ambassadors@schr.org. Also, please feel free to send us a selfie or group photo once your race is over. Include your name, distance and time you completed the race.

- 8. How long is the race period? When will winners be announced? The race begins on February 1, 2021 and ends on February 14, 2021 at 11:59 pm. We will announce the winners by February 22, 2021 via email and on our website.
- 9. When can I expect to receive my Southern Center race incentives?

 The Southern Center for Human Rights race incentives will be mailed after the race period ends on February 14, 2021.



10. How do I create a fundraising page?

You can create a fundraising page for yourself, for a team, or join an already existing team.

1. Individuals

- **a.** Go to the event page and click on the "Register" button.

- **c.** Select if your registration is for you or someone else and click the "Next" button.
- d. When asked if you would like to start a team, select "No".

2. Team

- **a.** Go to the event page and click on the "Register" button.
- **b.** Select your registration level and click the "Add to Cart" button.
- **c.** Select if your registration is for you or someone else and click the "Next" button.
- **d.** When asked if you would like to start a team, select "Yes" or select any of the available options to join an existing Team.
